## **README**

### ***INTRODUCTION***

The object of Ballix is to guide the colored balls down the tracks to the matching colored holes. Sink the balls in their matching holes to complete the level.

You can use a variety of mechanisms to guide the balls down different tracks to their destination. See the in game Help for more information on the mechanisms available in game.

There are 42 levels of increasing difficulty in Ballix. Once you complete a level, the next available level will be unlocked for play. As well, you can go back to any level and replay it for a better score or better accuracy.

### ***INSTALLATION***

Ballix installation is simple. The SIS will ask where you want to install Ballix. Select the drive you want to install, and Ballix will begin installation to that media. A launcher will be created automatically and placed in the applications menu. Once installed, Ballix can be run by clicking on the application icon within the application menu.

### ***BACKUP***

This application is not intended to be backed up. If you need to restore your device, please re download the application and reinstall it.

### ***HELP***

For in game help on how to play Ballix, select the Help option in the Main menu.

## **USER GUIDE**

### ***STARTING BALLIX***

Once you've successfully installed Ballix, proceed to your applications menu and look for the Ballix icon. Click or tap this icon to launch the game in the native flash lite player.

### ***PLAYING BALLIX***

The object of Ballix is to guide the colored balls down the tracks to the matching colored holes. Sink the balls in their matching holes to complete the level.

You can use a variety of mechanisms to guide the balls down different tracks to their destination. See the in game Help for more information on the mechanisms available in game.

You can disable audio from the Main screen with the Audio option. Just tap it to enable/disable audio.
